Biography

Barbara A. Johnson is vice president of Enterprise Intelligence Solutions, a business unit of Raytheon Company's Intelligence and Information Systems (IIS) that supports ground systems (i.e., Multi-Int Systems) and provides large-scale data processing and exploitation storage architectures.
