Since joining Raytheon in 1984 as counsel for Raytheon's Missile Systems Division, Heller has held a number of positions of increasing responsibility, including assistant division counsel for the Missile Systems Division, division counsel for Raytheon's Equipment Division, and director of legal for Raytheon Command, Control, Communication and Information Systems (C3I) headquarters.

Prior to joining Raytheon, Heller served as a judge advocate for the U.S. Air Force (USAF) Judge Advocate General's (JAG) Department from 1979 to 1984. Before assuming this position, he practiced law in the private sector in Massachusetts and Florida.

In addition to his role as vice president of legal for IDS, Heller is currently a reservist in the USAF JAG Department, serving in the rank of colonel.

Heller's affiliations include the American Bar Association and the American Corporate Counsel Association.

Heller received his bachelor's degree in history from the University of Massachusetts Amherst and his juris doctor from Northeastern University School of Law. He was born in Boston, Mass.
