Biography

Mary D. Petryszyn is vice president of Civil Security and Response Programs for Raytheon Integrated Defense Systems (IDS). Raytheon Company (NYSE: RTN), with 2008 sales of \$23.2 billion, is a technology and innovation leader specializing in defense, homeland security and other government markets throughout the world. With headquarters in Waltham, Mass., Raytheon employs 73,000 people worldwide.

Integrated Defense Systems is Raytheon's leader in Global Capabilities Integration providing affordable, integrated solutions to a broad international and domestic customer base, including the U.S. Missile Defense Agency, the U.S. Armed Forces and the Department of Homeland Security.

The Civil Security and Response Programs (CSRP) business area is focused on the market space associated with Defense of Nations, with key competencies in surveillance and decision support systems. CSRP includes the Advanced Spectroscopic Portal (ASP) and Athena programs, and other IDS growth initiatives with Department of Homeland Security, Department of Defense, and international customers. Work is performed at mission centers located in Colorado, Massachusetts and Rhode Island.

Prior to this position, Petryszyn was vice president of Joint Battlespace Integration, providing warfighting capabilities in the areas of maritime domain awareness, wide area surveillance, and space situational awareness to Department of Defense and international customers. Petryszyn joined Raytheon in 1986 as a systems engineer and has held a wide

range of challenging positions. She was also the Strategy Executive for Raytheon IDS, leading strategy development, merger and acquisition activities, competitive intelligence, and congressional and community relations for the business.

In addition to her professional accomplishments, Petryszyn serves on the Corporate Partnership Council for the Society of Women Engineers (SWE); the Corporate Advisory Council for the Women in Engineering Program at the University of Colorado (CU) at Boulder; and the Raytheon IDS Executive Inclusive Culture and Community Relations Councils. She is a life member of SWE and the Girl Scouts of the USA. Petryszyn received the prestigious SWE Upward Mobility Award in 2005 for her contribution to the engineering field. She has served on the Colorado Governor's Commission on Higher Education Science and Technology Committee; the Board of Directors for Colorado Mile Hi Girl Scout Council; and the Girl's Exploring Science, Engineering, and Technology Event committee. She received the 2000 Woman of Distinction Award from Mile Hi Girl Scout Council.
