Steve Teel leads Global Training Solutions as a vice president for Raytheon Technical Services Company LLC (RTSC), a wholly owned subsidiary of Raytheon Company. RTSC provides technical, scientific and professional services for defense, federal and commercial customers worldwide.

Teel is responsible for leading strategic growth and developing a comprehensive integrated global training business for RTSC. GTS's Cyber training initiative represents their latest market vertical entry. He was also responsible for capturing the \$11.2-billion Warfighter FOCUS program awarded to RTSC in 2007. The program provides training and training support globally for the U.S. Army.

In his previous position as vice president for Business Development, Teel coordinated and managed a business development organization of 100 individuals. He also oversaw the company's strategic plan and customer satisfaction focus.

As vice president of business development for Raytheon Company's Command, Control, Communication and Information (C3I) Systems business, Teel had responsibility for strategic business plans, customer satisfaction, discretionary resources for business development and consultant and representative selection.
