Charles Keegan is the program manager for the Air Traffic Control Optimum Training Solution program for Raytheon Technical Services Company (RTSC) LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Raytheon Company.

Keegan was previously Raytheon's Network Centric Systems director of Strategic Development, Airspace Management and Homeland Security.
