As General Manager of Mission Solutions, Julie is accountable to the Managing Director for Raytheon Australia's operational and deeper level maintenance activities related to aerospace capability and systems. In this role, Julie is also accountable for the operations at the Naval Communications Station, Harold E Holt in Exmouth and the provision of commercial training outcomes with a number of major organisations.

Julie was previously the Director, Joint Air Warfare Systems, where she was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the product line which included Project AIR3024 (Woomera Range Upgrade), aerospace in service support programs, simulation and training, the delivery of electronic warfare training solutions and air traffic systems.

Julie joined the company in 2001 as a structural engineer, but soon afterwards moved into project management. She has since been employed in various strategic, project leadership, operations and business development roles, including the Raytheon Australia Strategy Executive, AWD Combat System Training Facilities and Services Program Manager, Industry Fellow at the Australian Defence College, and the Program Manager for the Sydney-based Aerospace Systems Integration group.

Prior to joining Raytheon Julie held various roles in carbon fibre research engineering and structural engineering at Hawker De Havilland and the Cooperative Research Centre for Aerospace Structures (Sydney), Daimler Benz Aerospace (Bremen, Germany), Boeing Commercial Aircraft Company (Seattle, USA) and British Aerospace (Bristol, UK).
