Responsible for all budgeting, forecasting and internal reporting requirements, Sam oversaw the delivery of the companies monthly results and forecasts, annual operating plan and Long Range Plans and analysis of the company's financial data and performance.

Prior to joining Raytheon Australia Sam spent a number years within the Oil & Gas industry in Australia, London & Edinburgh in the UK, focussing heavily on financial analysis and reporting for many of the operating divisions within these companies.
