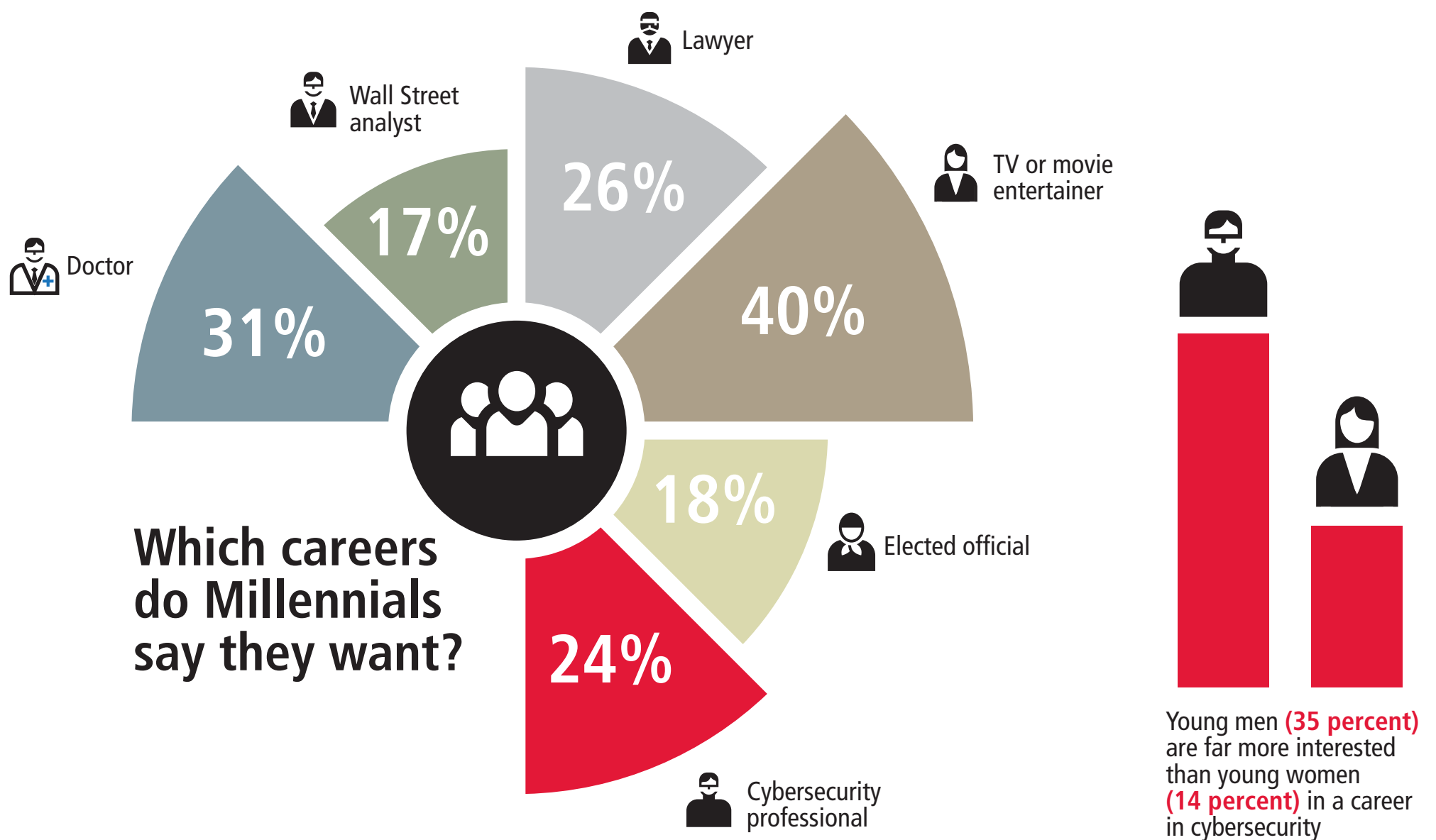


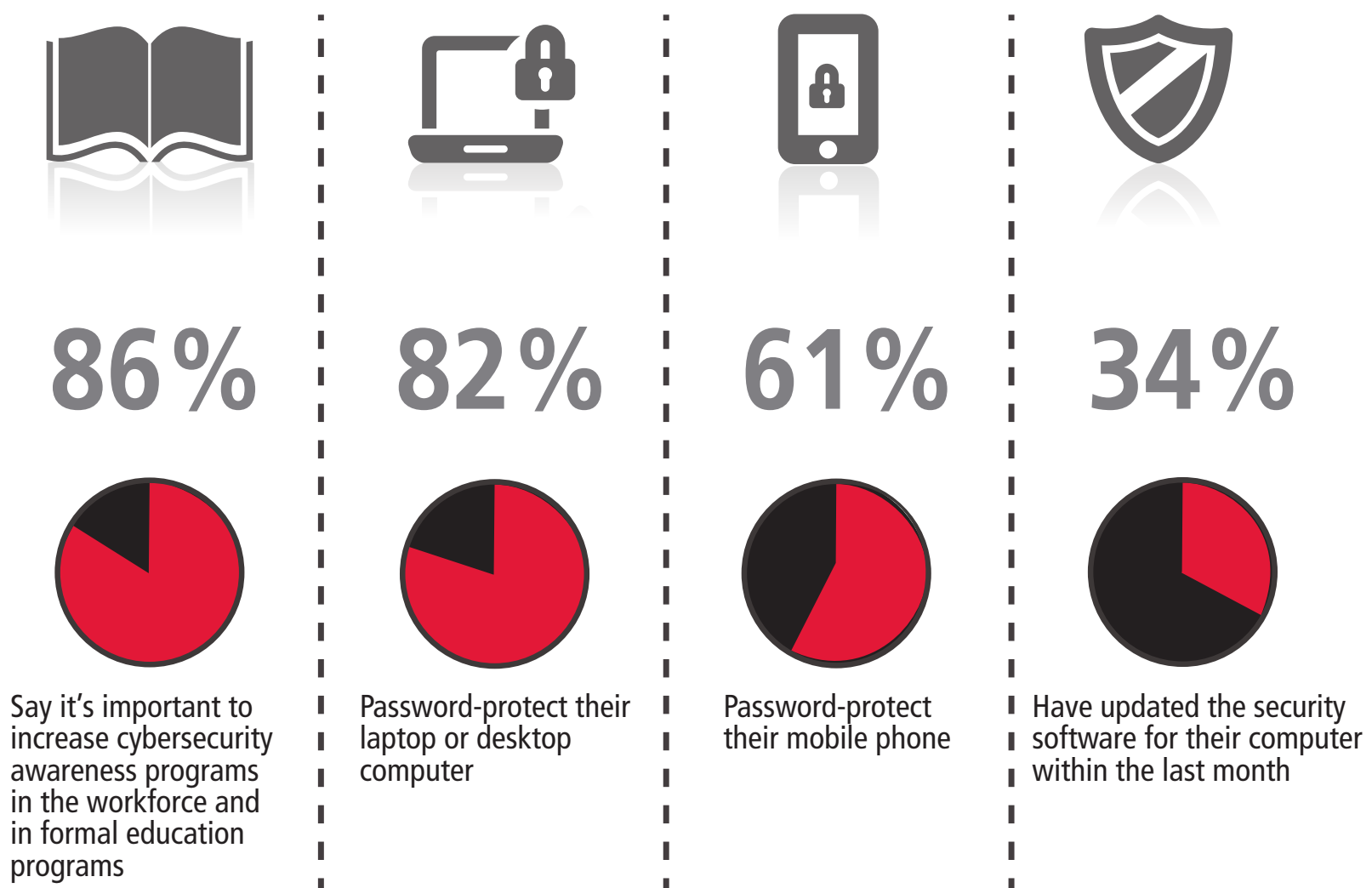
BUILDING TOMORROW'S CYBERSECURITY WORKFORCE

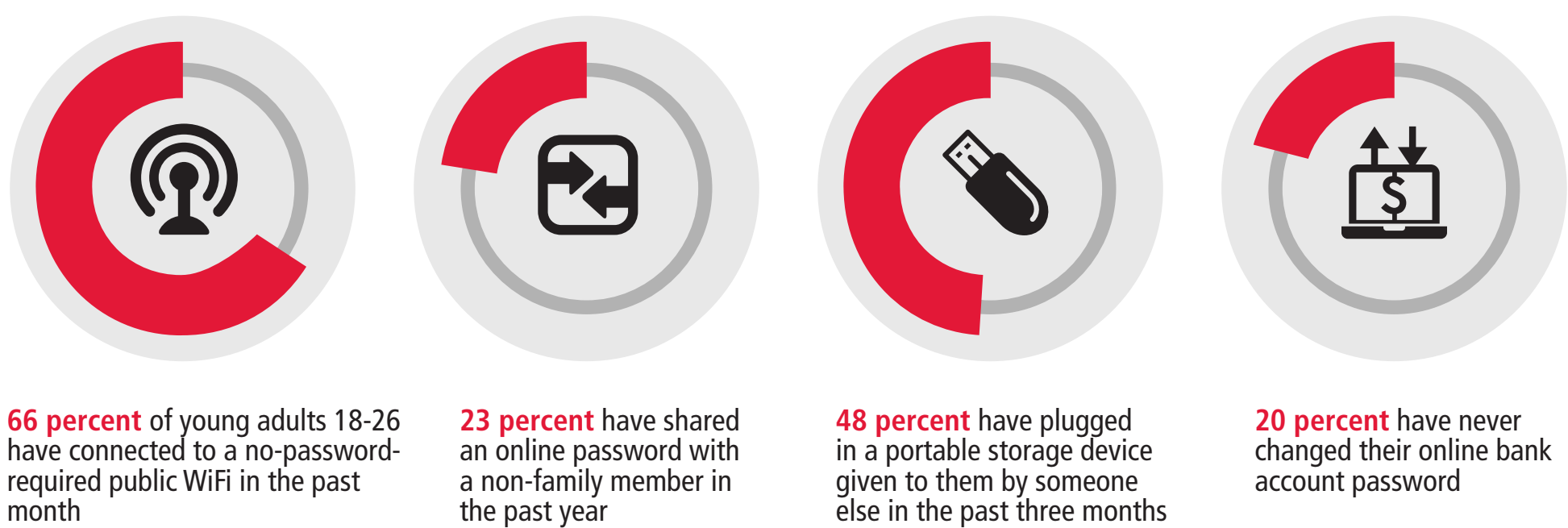


MILLENNIALS ARE TAKING STEPS TO PROTECT THEMSELVES ONLINE
